PEN PAPER TESTS

Pen paper tests must test core competencies and discourage rote learning. An ideal pen test must be balance, with a variety of question items ranging from testing knowledge to understanding, application of concepts, analysis, evaluation, and creative expression (Bloom's Taxonomy).

DIFFICULTY LEVEL : The difficulty level of the tests must be such that 50% test items can be attempted by an average student, 40% by good students, and 10% by extremely outstanding students.
